



## **Nurse Oncology Education Program Faculty Training Program**

### ***Eligibility***

Applicant must:

- Be a registered nurse, currently licensed in Texas
- Be employed by a Texas School of Nursing and teach RN students
- Develop a Personal Action Plan during the course of the program that identifies specific, measurable ways the participant will work during the following academic year to increase the oncology content in her/his classroom and/or in the school's curriculum
- Be willing to participate in follow-up surveys of the program's impact

### ***To apply, please submit***

1. Completed Application
2. Letter of Support from Dean/Director of School of Nursing, which:
  - Defines the degree to which the participant will be able to share content with other faculty members.
  - Discusses how the participant will be able to teach oncology content to nursing students in clinical and classroom settings.
  - Explains how the Dean/Director will support the participant in implementation of the oncology curriculum.
3. One page narrative to include the applicant's:
  - Specific clinical interests
  - Oncology teaching and practice experience
  - Area of teaching
  - Current patient population and clinical areas of teaching
4. Current Curriculum Vitae or Résumé
5. Signed Letter of Agreement

### ***Registration fee***

The scholarship includes

- 5 days of didactic and clinical observation in oncology education
- Approximately 25 contact hours of CNE
- Hotel accommodations (room only) and daily transportation to/from MDACC
- Lunch each day (a breakfast buffet is served by the hotel)

Participants are responsible for the cost of transportation to Houston and other meals, along with a \$250 non-refundable registration fee. NOEP recognizes that cost should not be a barrier to attendance by lower-income nursing faculty or by those who teach at under-resourced schools of nursing. *Letter of Agreement***

1. Upon acceptance to the program, NOEP will provide one scholarship per person to attend the Faculty Training Program. Scholarship includes:
  - a. 5 days of didactic and clinical observation in oncology education
  - b. Approximately 25 contact hours of CNE
  - c. Hotel accommodations (room only) and daily transportation to/from MDACC
  - d. Lunch each day (a breakfast buffet is served by the hotel)
2. The recipient agrees to participate in all seminar activities including lectures, clinical observation and evaluation.
3. The recipient agrees to prepare and implement a Personal Action Plan related to integrating learned content into the school's curriculum.
4. The recipient agrees to serve as a resource person for NOEP in their geographical region and for the sponsoring School of Nursing.
5. The recipient agrees to complete an electronic survey at the end of the following fall and spring semesters and submit agreed-upon documentation of completion of their Personal Action Plan.
6. The recipient agrees to forfeit the scholarship if s/he (a) is no longer a faculty member at a Texas School of Nursing at the time of the Faculty Training Program, (b) will not be a faculty member at the sponsoring School of Nursing during the academic year, or (c) fails to submit the \$250 non-refundable registration fee to NOEP, postmarked by April 30, 2012 (or request a waiver).
7. Clinical rotations will be assigned the week of FTP, based on hospital availability.
